



Chartered Membership MCIWEM C.WEM

1. Who can join as a Chartered Member?

The requirements for Chartered Membership are an honours degree (or equivalent), and relevant professional experience. You will need to demonstrate all 14 Mandatory Competences using the experience that you have. To see the mandatory competencies please log into your application and download the guidance.

2. Why become a Chartered Member?

- Successful applicants will be entitled to use the industry recognised post-nominal designation of C.WEM.
- Receive publications including The Environment magazine and e-newsletters.
- Opportunities to network through CIWEM Regional team.

3. How to become a Chartered Member?

4. How much does Chartered Membership cost?

There is an application fee for Member of £151. Existing CIWEM members will not be required to pay this application fee, but will be billed a transfer fee of £50.

All Chartered Member candidates will be called in for a Professional Interview after their application has been assessed at a relevant Professional Standards Committee meeting. The fee for the Professional Review is £195.

For successful applications made by non-members, a pro-rata subscription fee is required. The annual fee is currently £272.
