



## **Fellow FCIWEM C.WEM**

### **1. Who can join as a Fellow of CIWEM?**

Fellow is our highest grade of membership and is designed for those who have a significant level of experience in a senior role. There are 2 routes to fellowship at CIWEM: Direct Entry and Transfer to Fellow. 'Transfer to Fellow' is when an existing Member wishes to transfer their membership up to the Fellow grade. Direct Entry Fellows are those who aren't in a grade of membership with CIWEM, and are applying for the first time.

For those seeking Direct entry into Fellowship, please note that the academic requirements for Chartered Membership (an Honours Degree), professional experience (at a senior level for Fellows), as well as the successful demonstration of all 14 of CIWEM's Mandatory Competences apply. Individuals who are not existing Chartered Members of CIWEM will have to successfully pass the Professional Review Interview in order to be awarded the fellow grade of membership. To see the mandatory competencies please login to your application and download the guidance.

Individuals transferring to Fellowship from Chartered level who have already undergone a Professional Review through CIWEM will not have to undergo a further review in order to be awarded this grade of membership.

### **2. Why become a Fellow?**

- Successful applicants will be entitled to use the industry recognised post-nominal designation of CIWEM.
- Receive publications including The Environment magazine and e-newsletters.
- Network opportunities through the CIWEM Regional team.

### **3. How to become a Fellow:**

The application for Chartered Member is completed online, follow this link for the online application.

For applicants who are new to CIWEM you will need to follow the Chartered Membership application process and provide the below.

For applicants who are already CIWEM Chartered Members please provide a 100 word Career Report, 3 CIWEM Fellow sponsors, your most current CV and 3 years CPD.

### **4. How much does Fellowship cost?**

For a non-member, there is an application fee of £151. If you are an existing member of CIWEM seeking to transfer to the grade of fellowship, please note that you won't need to submit an application fee, however you will be invoiced a transfer fee of £50.

For Direct Entry Fellows invited to a Professional Interview after the initial application, a fee Professional Review Fee of £195 will be billed.

If you are successful and elected as a Member, a pro-rata subscription fee is required. The annual pro-rata fee currently is £272.
