Work Based Learning Mandatory Competence Supplementary Statement Form

In addition to holding exemplifying qualifications (Honour's Level) to demonstrate the knowledge and understanding elements of professional competence, there are other ways a candidate can demonstrate the necessary knowledge and understanding for progression to Chartered Water and Environmental Manager.

Candidates are required to provide a reflective statement describing the specific knowledge and understanding they have gained through their work (and any other relevant activity) for each QAA Descriptor in addition to the requirements of a standard submission. This should be supported by evidence of any assessment or evaluation which has taken place. Candidates should not replicate examples from their Mandatory Competencies but demonstrate a breadth of experience from their career.
